- **Teenage pregnancy**

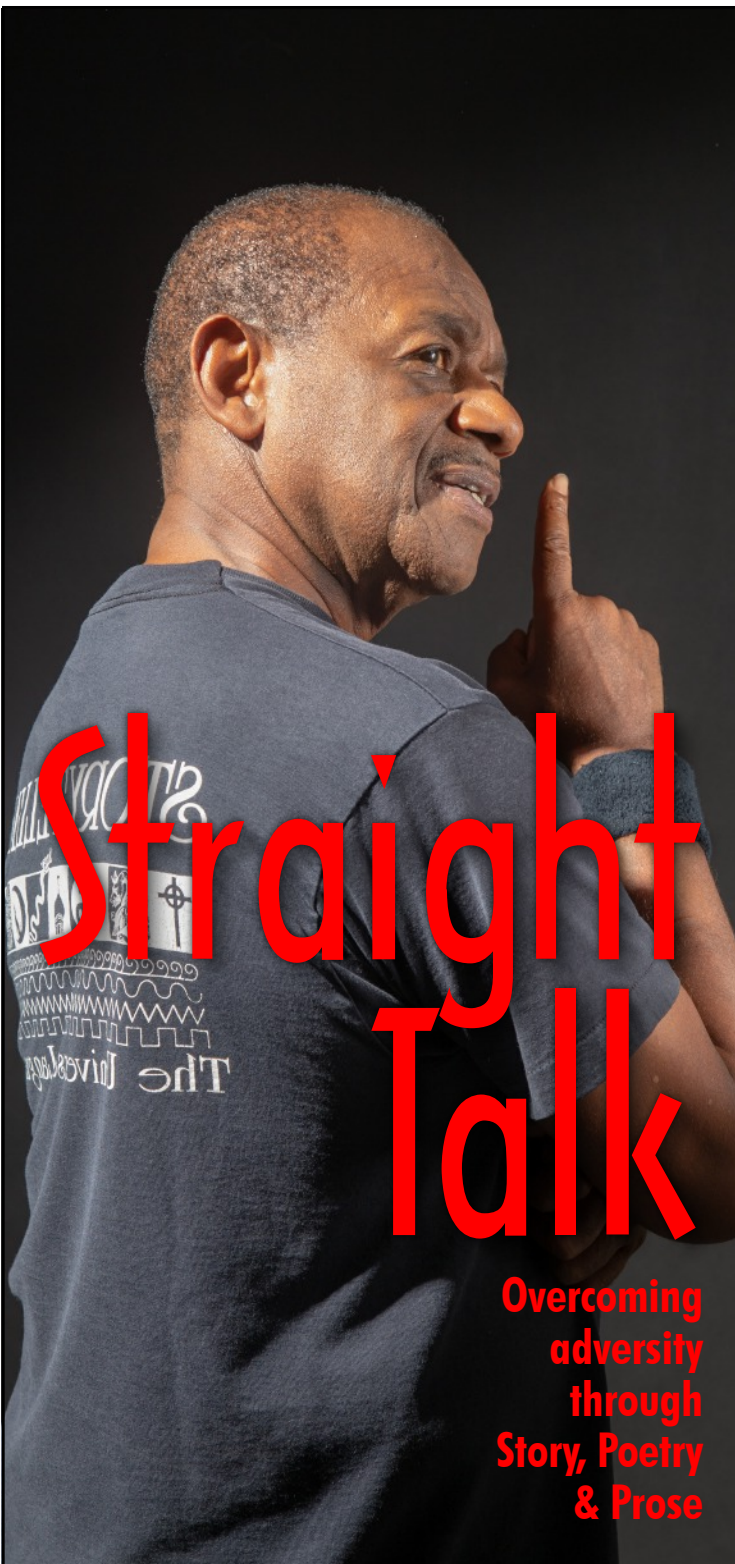
